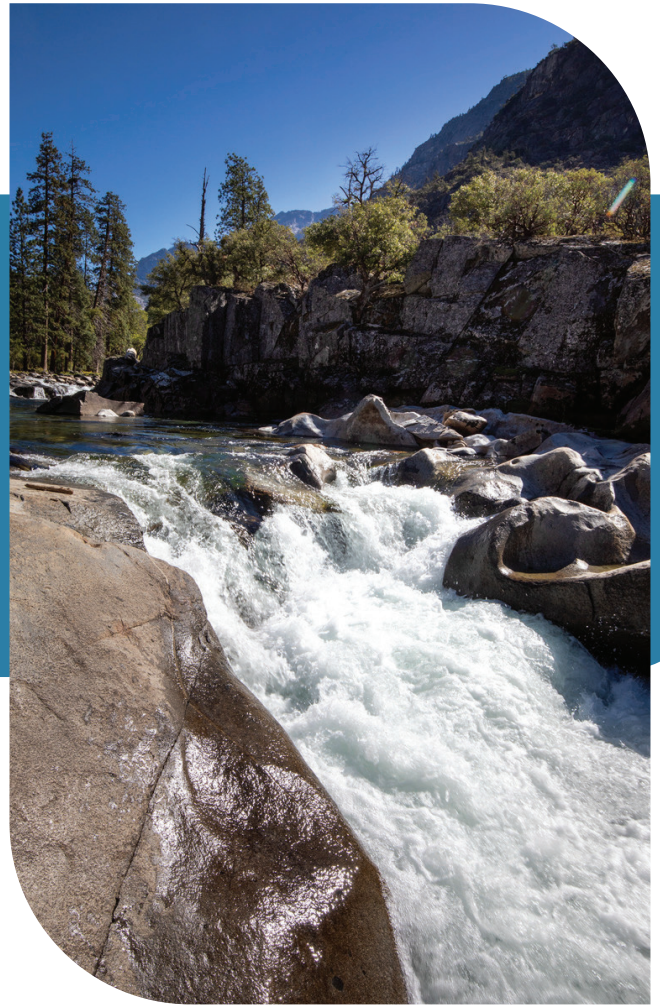


WHO WE ARE

Organizational Overview

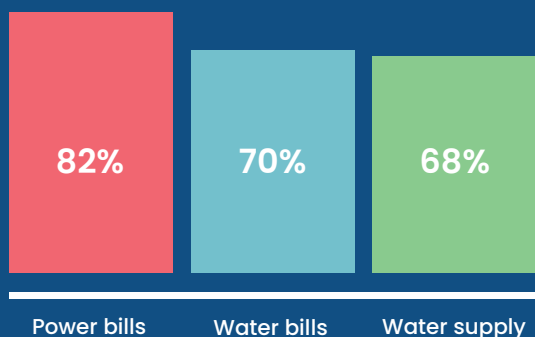
The San Joaquin Tributaries Authority was established in 2012 as a Joint Powers Authority. Today, we are governed by four appointed commissioners—one from each member agency: Modesto Irrigation District, San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, South San Joaquin Irrigation District, and Turlock Irrigation District. Together, we are working to build collaboration, understanding, and sustainable stewardship for the tributaries of the San Joaquin River.



What Voters Are Saying

We surveyed 1,500 registered voters in the Bay Area and Central Valley. A strong majority of voters say they are somewhat concerned or very concerned about their power and water bills as well as their water supply.

Voter Concerns

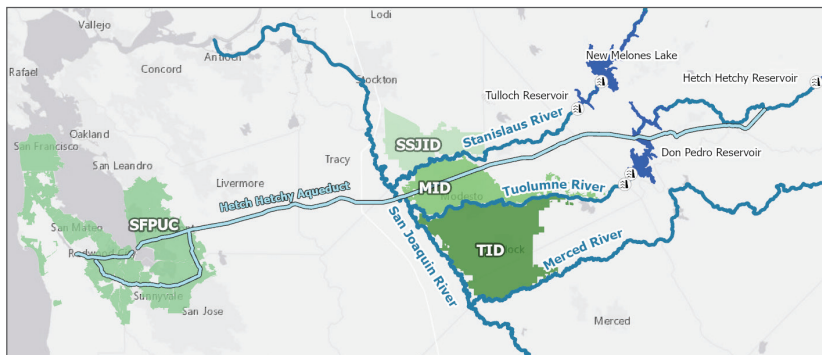
